# **October 2022 Operating Report Notes**

- Additional \$25K State of Iowa grant received in October. \$113K total grant money received will be used to partially fund pre-school payroll costs this FY.
- Net Operating Income (Total Income minus Ignite and minus Total Expenses plus Depreciation) is positive YTD, due to the above-mentioned \$113K in grant income. Without the \$113K in grant income, NOI would be negative by about \$80K. With it factored in, however, NOI is positive YTD at \$33,533. The Ignite proceeds were booked incorrectly in October. They should not be on the Income Statement; the proceeds will go into the 121420004 Capital Campaign Income and will be deposited into the Building Fund. Sorry for this confusion.
- \$15K of "lost income" from Faith Formation fee issue, is a significant factor to YTD income being lower than at this point last year. The loss was \$17,000.
- Hopefully November-launched tithing campaign will help bolster income for the remainder of the fiscal year.

### **Capital Improvement Notes**

- Parking lot and driveway/sidewalk concrete work has been completed.
- Camera, security door/electrification locks, and doorbell work is still being completed.

# **Tithing Campaign Update**

Tithing pledge cards have started to come in from parishioners. The hope is we receive cards from some members who have not been regular tithers in the past. ## **Ignite Capital Campaign Update**

• First distribution of \$174,486 was received in October. As was agreed to in September, 1/3 of this total will be given to the OLIH Foundation. Remaining Ignite capital campaign money will be used for future capital improvements needed at OLIH.
