Our Lady's Immaculate Heart Church Faith Formation Scholarship Application

Objective

To recognize and encourage continued participation in the Faith Formation program of Our Lady's Immaculate Heart Parish beyond Confirmation and to participate in the faith life of the parish.

<u>Eligibility</u> - To qualify as an award recipient a youth must be:

- Registered along with his/her family at Our Lady's Immaculate Heart Parish.
- Registered for and have attended with regularity Youth Faith Formation Sessions of the parish at all grade levels (Pre-K through 12).
- Be a full-time student entering an institution of higher learning, trade or certificate program, and plan to attend such directly upon graduation from high school.
- Able to demonstrate strength in your high school preparation and promise for continued academic success.
- Able to demonstrate leadership and involvement in Our Lady's Immaculate Heart Church Faith Community.
- Submit one (1) Application for Our Lady's Immaculate Heart Faith Formation Scholarship

Determination of Awards - The criteria used to determine the award recipients includes, but is not limited to, Youth Faith Formation attendance, participation in the ministries of Our Lady's Immaculate Heart Church, participation in youth ministry, liturgy, music and vacation bible school, involvement in school and community activities. **The content, length and neatness of the essay is given serious consideration.** Point values are assigned and vary by category with Youth Faith Formation attendance having the most weight.

Items to submit

1. A typed application. Only 1 application is needed to be considered for all scholarships listed below.

2. A typed essay 150-250 words or more addressing the following:

- In detail, share about your faith journey, explain how attending and participating in the Youth Faith Formation Sessions at Our Lady's has affected you.
- Describe how one event/situation of participation in the life of the parish (prayer, study, worship and action) has had an effect on your understanding of God and/or how God in Christ Jesus is still relevant in today's world.
- Explain how you plan to continue your growth in the Catholic faith. How do you plan to love God and neighbor in the days, months and years ahead? Where do you see yourself practicing your faith 10 years from now?

3. Two letters of reference.

The person should reference your overall character and include:

• How they witness you being involved in and/or living your Catholic faith?

4. A recent photo – for use in parish publications

Availability

Applications are accepted February 1 – March 31 each year and is open to all who meet the eligibility requirements above.

Award Notification

All Scholarship applicants are notified by email with congratulations or regrets. Awardees are recognized at a recognition event held annually in the month of May.
