- ➤ Volunteering has taken a "hit" since the pandemic. There is "volunteer fatigue" & some fear of leadership due to the responsibilities.
- > Discussed how we do have several organizations that use our facility for Community events
- Feedback: "What are you hearing?" All council members

- Question about the structure of "Neighborhood Groups"
  - Structure is up to the group
  - Fr. Michael indicated this is a an experiment of sorts & how the groups function & for how long is unknown at this time
  - Anna advised that Patty has been impressed with the numbers who have signed up to date
- Question of why it is so cold in the sanctuary. No real reason, just is.
- o **Daily Chapel** need to have the sound on in the chapel; a woman in mass was asked to move (by another parishioner) to the Daily Chapel because her child was too loud.
  - Fr. Michael made a note to have the sound on for daily mass in the Chapel
  - Group felt it was not appropriate for the Parishioner to make this request of the mother
  - Agreed there are times when a child needs to be removed but it is not responsibility of Parishioners to make that decision for the parents
  - Discussed how PC could intervene to gently remind the Parish that everyone is welcome.
    - Suggested to have a monthly blurb in the bulletin from the Parish Council where we could address this item with a gentle but intentional message
    - > Ty suggested to have a QR code as well to allow people ability to give us feedback without having to directly speak to one of us. Will need to determine setup of this & where the feedback will go. Suggested that it come to Vicki for distribution to the PC.
    - Renae will research & provide additional info in September meeting
- o Discussed that there might be too much consecrated blood left in the Chalice. Suggested to ask others on Eucharistic team to drink it if not comfortable doing that
- o People are looking for more confession times in the evenings.
- o During the 40 Hours of Adoration in October, there will be more confession times offered
- Pastor Report
  - Parish Fr. Michael
    - ADA-Generated more than \$10,000 this weekend, did not reach goal

- Does church use Venmo? Would be a great option for people that don't carry checks
- Might also setup a QR code to gather more donations
