  - Have 70 classes (11 youth per class)
  - Target of keeping groups small.
- VBS: Welcome Klaire Madden and Emily Phommachack as Co Directors
  - o Theme: Scuba, dive into God's love. Learn about Saints, feast days, scriptures.
- Heads up from dioceses: Age of when confirmation should be celebrated.
  - Learn what the church doc say about catechesis, scope and sequence of Faith Formation happenings, the program will change completely.
  - The advisory group will consider options from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
  - There will be a recommended grade level
  - o Order of sacraments will be: baptism-confirmation-eucharist.

  - This edict comes out from US Bishops Conference:
  - o There will be conversations with other dioceses that follow the "Restore Order"
  - This time next year the decision will be made but put in place the following year (2026). There will be a transition time (2025).
  - o Restore Order: baptism as infant, 2nd grade confirmation-eucharist at same time
