

- Appliances (Large) ex. Refrigerators, Freezers, Humidifiers, Dehumidifiers, Air Conditioners, etc.
- Baby Beds, Cribs, Car Seats, Toddler Bed Rails (Please check all baby gear for recalls. See link above.)
- Beds Box/Coil Springs, Headboards, Mattresses, Metal Frames, Hide-A-Beds, Sleeper Sofas, Water beds
- Car/Motorcycle Batteries, Tires, Rims, Oil/Air Filters, Seats
- Carpet & Padding
- Chemicals/Fertilizers/Herbicides/Pesticides
- Computer Monitors, Parts, Printers
- Encyclopedias
- Firearms
- Furniture (Large) Entertainment Centers, Hutches, Armoires
- Gas/Oil based products
- Home Improvement/Building Materials: Please take these items to ReStore (Habitat for Humanity, 2200 E Euclid, DSM) Blinds, Carpet, Lighting Fixtures, Bricks, Lumber, Doors, Windows, Siding, Shutters, Screens, Cabinets, etc.
